Officers' Reports:

Secretary (Jeff Dick)

- A motion was made/seconded (Tony Giunta/Chad Tylka) to approve the May meeting minutes as printed. Motion passed unanimously.

- The Player Development Committee made the following proposal regarding the Fall clinic:
 - Fall clinic will be run by Scott Steffen for all levels above Squirt/10U. The clinic will run from Tuesday, September 6th through Friday, September 30th for a total of 8-10 hours. The rate for all levels above Squirt/10U will be \$115. The Advanced Mite rate will be \$95. These rates are based on 8 hours. The rate will increase \$5 for each additional hour.

A Bill Hahlbreder just completed his fifth season as an assistant coach for the Augsburg women's hockey team. Native of Duluth, Minn., Halbrehder played hockey on the junior level in Moose Jaw, Sask., for two years before playing collegiate at the University of Minnesota-Duluth. After earning his degree from Duluth, Halbrehder began coaching and teaching. For 21 years (1968-89), he coached boys' hockey at North St. Paul, Minn., HS, while also coaching boys' soccer for 12 years and girls' soccer for 13 years.



For seven years (1992-99), Halbrehder was the athletic director at North St. Paul HS. Halbrehder earned his master's degree in physical education and sport physiology from Bemidji State University in 1980. He retired in 1999 from his teaching and athletic director position.
